



Conditions of Entry House Rules

ENTRY TO THE CLUB

- Members entering the club are required to produce their membership card to Front Desk Personal to sight
- Members and their guests must adhere to the dress code and standards of the Club and its Management and designated staff have the authority to determine if the dress standard is met. *(Please refer to the Clubs Dress regulations listed below)*
- The front desk personal is authorised to ensure that all visitors enter the club in accordance with the requirements of the licensing laws.
- In any dispute regarding entry to the club, Front Desk personnel will refer the matter to Management.
- Management reserves the right to refuse entry to any visitors without explanation.
- Any member or visitor will be refused entry to the club if it deemed that person is intoxicated, appears to be nearing or showing signs of intoxication or is inadequately dressed.

MEMBERS GUESTS

- A member bringing a guest or guests into the Club will be required to sign the Members Guest Register against the name of each visitor.
- The member will be responsible for the guest's behaviour whilst the guest is on or near the premises.
- Any misconduct or breach of House Rules by a guest may be regarded as a breach by the member responsible for that guest.
- Guests who have been signed in shall not remain on the premises after the member who has signed them in has left.

VISITORS

Visitors are welcomed at the Club however if unaccompanied by a member the visitor must:

- Reside more than 5km away from the Club, or
- Be a member of another club that has similar objectives, or

- Be a member of another Club and invited to attend an organised sporting event.
- Present Identification with a current residential address and must sign in as a visitor, to obtain a temporary membership, or
- Complete an application for Membership and request to join the club as a financial member.

PROOF OF AGE

- When required by a Club officer, proof of age must be established (being passport, drivers licence or photo card).
- Persons under the age of eighteen will not be permitted in restricted areas.
- Persons under the age of eighteen must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Persons under the age of eighteen must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

CLUB DRESS RULES

Contemporary standards and common sense are the grounding principles of the dress code.

Dress rules apply to children 15 years and older. Children aged 14 years and younger are required to dress in neat and age appropriate attire.

Dress NOT permitted at any time:

- Football shorts or short shorts that expose the buttocks or crouch when walking, sitting or standing.
- No Revealing or provocative or immodest clothing
- Overalls or soiled work attire
- Offensive T-shirts
- Gentlemen are not allowed to wear singlets or sleeveless tops
- Untidiness, faded or frayed clothing
- Barefoot. (Exclusions are made to barefoot bowls)
- Swimwear, bathers, bikini tops or similar beachwear
- Leotards / bike shorts
- Football/soccer or studded boots
- Bandanas, caps and beanies and other forms of non-religious headwear. Medical headwear is allowed.
- Jewellery & accessories which can be used as a weapon (i.e knuckle busters, large dress rings, studded belts/collars.
- No Men's headwear
- Fancy dress costumes need to be pre-approved by management

Obscene or offensive language or clothing will not be tolerated.

Dress thongs are permitted

Appearance must be clean, neat and tidy always. Club management reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone if, in their opinion, their standard of dress or behaviour is considered unsuitable for South West Rocks Country Club.

CONDUCT

- To ensure the comfort of all patrons, no member or guest may create undue noise or cause a disturbance on the premises.
- Offensive language will not be tolerated within or in the surrounds of the Club.
- All patrons must respect the privacy of other members and guests always.
- Members and guests are requested to leave the premises in a quiet orderly manner respecting our neighbours.

RESPONSIBLE SERVICE OF ALCOHOL

Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) refers to the service, consumption, and promotion of alcoholic products in a manner that minimises the potential harm that may be caused by alcohol consumption to individuals, their families, and the community in general.

RESPONSIBLE CONDUCT OF GAMBLING

Responsible Conduct of Gambling (RCG) refers to the delivery of gaming and wagering services in a manner that minimises the potential harm that may be caused by gambling to individuals, their families, and the community in general.

The Clubs Responsible Conduct of Gambling (RCG) can be viewed at reception and is also located on our webpage.

CAR PARKING

- The Club Car Park is for members, guests, and authorised personnel, use only when visiting the premises. If a car is to be left in the car park, specific permission must be sought and granted by Management.
- Members and guests are responsible for their cars and their contents. All care must be taken when parking in the car park.
- When leaving the car park, members and guests are requested to do so carefully and quietly.

SMOKING

In accordance to the Smoke-Free Environment Act 2000, smoking is not permitted in:

- Any indoor or enclosed area of the club
- Any outdoor seated dining area of the club
- Within 4 metres of a seated dining area within the club
- Within 4 metres of a pedestrian access or exit point to the club

COURTESY BUS

The bus is deemed to be part of the Club, therefore all House Rules apply.

- Smoking, eating and drinking are not permitted whilst on board the bus.
- The bus driver has the discretion to refuse passengers.
- Please contact Front Desk Personnel for the bus boundary map, and scheduled pick up times.

SUBSCRIPTIONS

- Membership subscriptions fall due each year on 1st July and are payable in advance from mid-May.
- A member becomes un-financial after 30th June and has one month to rectify this position.
- Under no circumstances are membership cards transferable. No member may lend his/her card to another person.
- A membership card is not valid until signed by the member to whom it is issued.

GENERAL

- Any breach of these House Rules will be deemed as an offence and dealt with accordingly.
- Any member, who commits a misdemeanour and is to be cited to appear before the Board of Directors, will surrender his. or her membership card until he or she appears before the Board of Directors.
- Any question as to the interpretation or application of these House Rules will be submitted in writing to the Chief Executive Officer, who will forthwith submit same to the Board of Directors.
- Where any House Rule is inconsistent with any provision of the Liquor Act, Gaming, and Betting (Poker Machine) Act or other relevant legislation, the provisions of those Acts will prevail.
- The onus is on every member to make him or herself acquainted always with the Club's Constitution and the House Rules. These documents are available on request.
- No person under the age of eighteen (18) years may be admitted as a member of the Club.
- Without in any way limiting the meaning of misdemeanour where used in these House Rules members acknowledge misdemeanours include any

action word, deed or behaviour of a member which may bring the Club into disrepute or cause the Club to have any recording made against the Club by any disciplinary, policing or regulatory authority.

- Patrons congregating may be moved on from an area where they are hindering traffic flow or because of security and Workplace, Health, and Safety policies.
